COLUMBARIUM RULES AND REGULATIONS

In order to preserve the solemnity and beauty of your columbarium, it is necessary that the following rules and regulations be observed:

- 1. Visiting hours are from sunup until sundown every day of the year weather permitting. During inclement weather the cemetery is closed to all visitors.
- 2. Nothing may be taped or glued or otherwise adhered to the front of the niche or any other part of the columbarium structure. Anything that is found adhered to the structure will be removed and discarded
- 3. Only bronze vases will be allowed by Shoreland Memorial Gardens to be attached to the front of the niche. Size and design of the vase will be determined, sold and installed by our staff. All niches will be allowed cameo photographs that will be sold, supplied and installed by Shoreland Memorial Gardens Cemetery.
- 4. Smoking, eating and drinking as well as pets are not permitted around the columbarium.
- 5. Flower arrangements, vigil lamps, potted plants are not permitted to be left in front of the columbarium. These items will be removed and discarded.
- 6. If ashes are removed from the niche at the families wishes, the family is responsible for replacing the niche front. Even if they decide not to inurn another set of cremains or sell the niche, the family is still responsible for the replacement of the niche front at the family's expense.
- 7. All rules are subject to change at the cemetery's discretion.

It is the desire of Shoreland Memorial Gardens Cemetery to maintain the cemetery and columbarium to the highest of standards as possible. It is with this idea in mind that we have established the foregoing rules and regulations
